Exploring Colors

Once upon a time, Lizzy opened her first box of crayons seeing the perfectly bright color array within. Continually awestruck by the hues she groups, orders, and patterns with various shades.

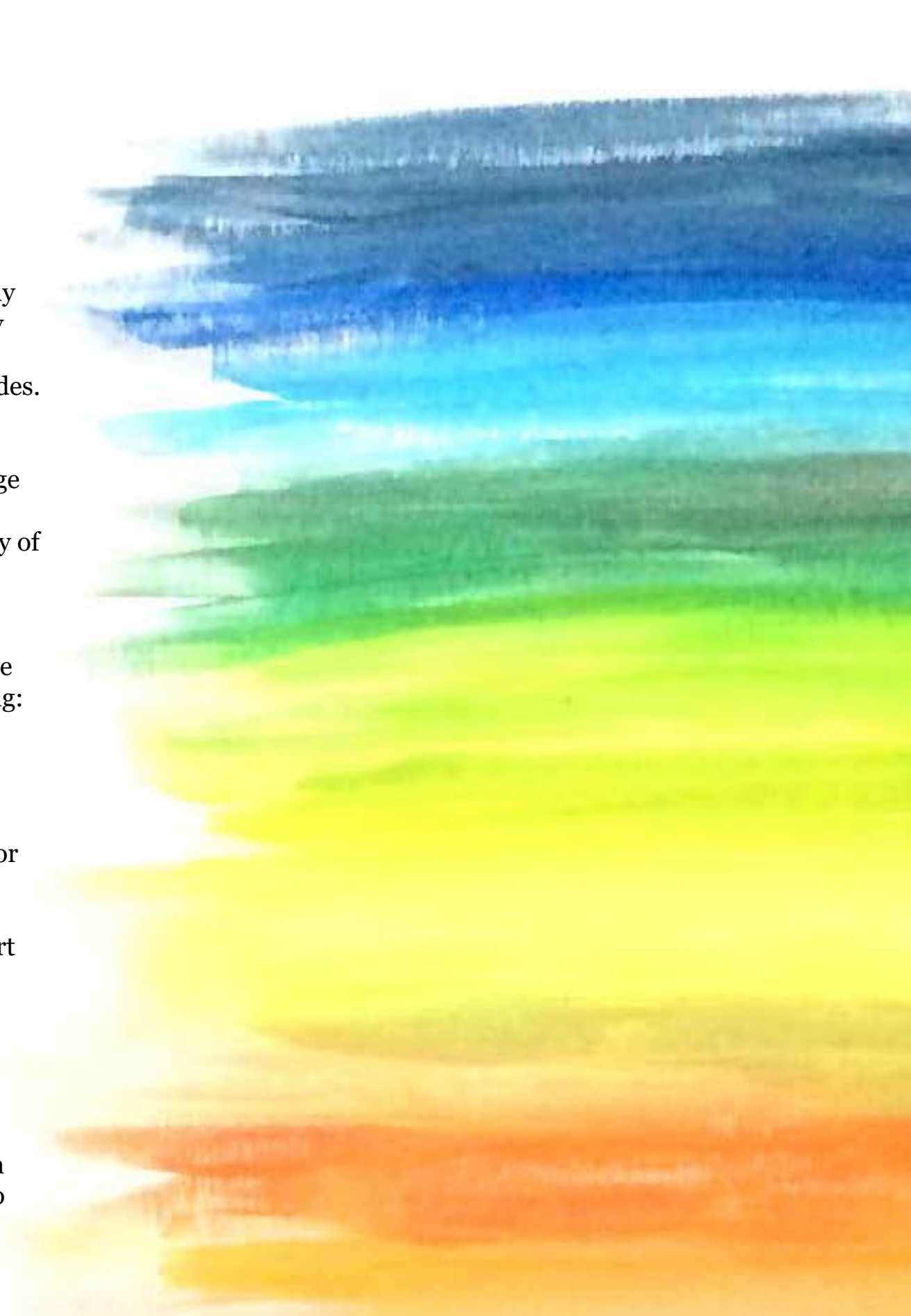
She always places emphasis on the spectrum order of colors. Since the age of eight, she has placed, grouped, and aligned items in a "rainbow" - as a way of achieving harmony.

In high school art class, she began to refine her color selections and over the years tested several medium, including: oil pastels, cut paper, colored pencil, water-color, and acrylics.

In 2014, Lizzy organized an on-street public art installation of vibrantly color streamers resembling the spectrum which activated a parking space in downtown Seattle for 8-hours as a part of Parking Day.

She shares her paintings with friends and donates them for charitable auctions.

To this day she takes great pleasure in creating a transition from one color to another.

Creating Peacock

Inspired by a hybrid peacock-floral fantasy art piece, Lizzy and her niece, Annmarie, created their own rendition of a life-sized peacock with floral train (84" x 56"). Replacing the peacock's feathers with florals is a unique interpretation and bring an element of whimsy.

This work hung as a distinctive focal point for her dining room and was a conversation piece for guests in her Kansas City home.

Translating Peacock from acrylic hand-painting to digital graphic allows the layering of color combinations to be vibrant and apparent in the print patterns.
