
A weathered "shack" by the beach and in the woods.


Working closely with one another constructing, problem-solving, and discussing - common ground is found in areas of life extending beyond the task at-hand.

Reflection | Being Brave


Creating a second, distinctly-separate and selectively-connected, space is an imperative with the objective of:
